Why Choose Daylilies?

- Reliable perennial
- Minimal care required
- Long-lasting seasonal interest
- Suitable for almost any garden style

Planting Guide

Best Time to Plant:

- Spring or early fall

Spacing:

- 18–24 inches apart

Location:

- Full sun (best flowering)
- Partial shade (acceptable)

Soil:

- Well-draining preferred
- Tolerant of poor soil

Watering

- Keep moist during establishment
- Once established: water only during prolonged dry periods

Maintenance Checklist

- ✓ Remove spent flowers
- ✓ Cut back foliage after flowering
- ✓ Divide every 3–5 years

Dividing Daylilies

When:

- Spring or fall

Steps:


1. Lift the clump
2. Split into smaller sections
3. Replant with space to grow

Design Tips

- Plant in groups for impact
- Mix varieties for extended bloom time
- Use in borders, edges, or naturalistic planting

Pro Tips

- Combine early + late bloomers
- Pair with ornamental grasses for contrast
- Use repeat bloomers for longer displays
- Daylilies thrive on neglect—but respond beautifully to care.
